Security Concerns Have Heightened

- Unfortunately, recent security breaches involving Sensitive But Unclassified (SBU) and/or Personally Identifiable Information (PII) have caused the agency to tighten its data security belt
- Judgment Fund claims contain both SBU and PII Data
- Examples of such data are:
 - First name or Last Name or Both
 - Telephone numbers
 - Street addresses and
 - SSN's or EIN's, etc.....





What does that mean for JFICS?

- As a result JFICS was given a higher risk level designation
- All FMS systems now must conform to tighter access security requirements
- Consequently, access to JFICS requires a two-factor authentication
 - The Solution: Public Key Infrastructure (PKI)
 - PKI requires both passphrase and a physical token in order for Authentication and Authorization to occur (two-factor)





Required Steps for System Access

- Complete three required forms (unless you are a DOD user)
 - JFICS User Access Request Form
 - Rules of Behavior Form
 - PKI Certificate Action Request Form
 - DOD users do not fill out this form

- Initially, forms and instructions will be sent to users as access and training is scheduled (Phased approach)



Recommendations for Submitting Forms

- We prefer forms that are typewritten
- If hand written, print legibly
- Complete all fields within the forms
- Remember to sign and date forms
- Must use the Esker fax cover sheet
 - This form is downloadable from the Judgment Fund website





For Department of Defense Users

- If you are currently using Common Access Cards (CAC)
 - Conflicts/problems exist with PKI certificates
- We have an alternate approach for you CAC users
- It is the Secure ID Card
 - Secure ID Cards allow for remote logins without conflicts with CACs
