What is FedDebt?



- Current Debt Management Services (DMS) cross-servicing system
- Web-based application
- Create and update debt and debtor information
- Monitor financial transactions

Initial Strategy



- Improve functionality of systems used for cross-servicing (DMSC & PMAC)
- Enable automated processing and monitoring throughout the entire debt life cycle
- Provide web based access to all internal and external users

Current Operating Status



- Converted all collectible debts from systems previously used by Debt Management Services' Cross-Servicing
- Batch submission implemented October 2005
- Creditor agency users granted on-line access January 2006
- Over 1,000 on-line users

Daily Operations



- Continue to process and generate increasing batch files from creditor agencies and private collection agencies
- Optimize system performance through technological enhancements and performance testing
- Incorporate user-requested modifications
- User and system support

Latest Updates/Modifications



- Migration to newer platform with increased capabilities
- Administrative Wage Garnishment (AWG)
(Functionality now available at BDMOC)
- Department of Justice (DOJ) functionality

Future Enhancements



- Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) and datamart to create comprehensive reporting.
- Single sign-on interface for TOP and FedDebt
